

Cambridge Curriculum with GCSEPod by CambriCollege (Year 7 to IGCSE)

1. What is GCSEPod?

GCSEPod is an award-winning online platform that supports Cambridge IGCSE students with:

- Short, syllabus-aligned video lessons ("Pods")
- Interactive quizzes and assignments
- Clear progress tracking for parents and tutors

We integrate GCSEPod with tutor-led support to prepare students for Cambridge IGCSE exams.

2. Our Cambridge Programme (Year 7–11)

We follow the Cambridge pathway from **Lower Secondary** through **Upper Secondary**:

Stage	Age	Cambridge Level	SA Equivalent
Lower Secondary	11–14 Years	7–9	Grades 6–8
Upper Secondary	14–16	IGCSE	Grades 9–10/11

3. How Cambridge Exams Work

1. **Study with Us + GCSEPod**
 - Students cover Cambridge syllabus content with structured lessons and revision.
2. **Register for Exams**
 - Students must register at an **approved Cambridge exam centre** in the Western Cape (e.g., British Council Cape Town or certain Cambridge-registered private schools).
 - We assist with guidance on registration and deadlines.
3. **Write the Exams**
 - Written in person at the exam centre.
 - Exam sessions: **May/June** and **Oct/Nov**.
 - Papers are marked in the UK, and results are released by Cambridge.

4. Continuing After IGCSE (AS & A Levels in the Western Cape)

For AS or A Level studies, students can enrol with:

- British Council Cape Town (exam venue) + online providers such as CambriLearn, or Teneo Education

5. University Recognition

- **SA universities:** IGCSE + AS/A Levels can meet Matric exemption requirements if the correct subject combination is chosen.
- **Global universities:** Cambridge qualifications are widely recognised internationally.
